Requires the request to indicate the child's medical history and a description of recommended therapy. Requires provision of age-appropriate information regarding those medications to minors.

Requires notification of the exemption and if it will affect admission to postsecondary education and community college information.

Requires such payments to be allocated based on documented legal permanency outcomes for older children to improve such outcomes.

Provides for disbursement of moneys in the fund to the Department of Social Services for programs to increase public awareness and outreach regarding the Safely Surrendered Baby Law.

Requires the department to refer the youth to a government or nonprofit organization that provides information and assistance to victims of identity theft, if the consumer disclosure reveals any negative items, or evidence that identity theft has occurred.
